Subway

The Beauchef campus can be reached from various parts of the city via the Subway network. The closest stations to the Faculty are Parque O'Higgins and Toesca, both on line 2.

When you get off at Parque O'Higgins station, go out and walk west. Then, cross the street to a concrete esplanade: that is the entrance to the Park. You have to enter and cross it diagonally in a northwestern direction until the Tupper Street exit and walk west until the entrance located in Tupper 2007, where the Electrical Engineering building is located.

From the Toesca station, which is a little farther away, take the exit to the west and walk one block through the street that gives its name to the station, to Ejercito Libertador. When you get to this intersection, walk three blocks south to Blanco Encalada Avenue. Once there, walk one block further west to the intersection with Vergara Street, then cross Whitewashed Whitewashed Avenue to enter the Beauchef campus through the Geology building, located at Plaza Ercilla 803; or by Whitewashed Whitewashed Avenue 2002, where the Civil Engineering and Geophysics Building is located.

Micro - Bus

Some of the Transantiago routes that pass through the Beauchef campus are: bus line 506, from Maipú to Peñalolén, which in the middle of its route passes through Blanco Encalada Avenue. Useful for those who come from the communes of Maipú (Av. Pajaritos), Estación Central (Av. 5 de Abril), Santiago Centro (Av. Matta), Ñuñoa (Av. Grecia) and Peñalolén (Av. Grecia).

Another route is bus line 507, from Pudahuel to Peñalolén, which also passes through Blanco Encalada Avenue. Useful for those who come from the communes of Pudahuel (Av. José Joaquín Pérez), Quinta Normal (Av. Mapocho and Av. Matucana), Santiago Centro (Av. España and Av. Matta), Ñuñoa (Av. Grecia) and Peñalolén (Av. Grecia).

Bicycle

To get there by bicycle, there are some sections of bicycle lanes that take you to the Beauchef campus in streets such as Club Hípico or Avenida Matta in Santiago Centro.

Inside the Faculty there are several spaces for bicycle parking.

Automobile

If you arrive by car, we inform you that the Beauchef campus does not have public internal parking spaces at the moment. However, in the surroundings there are spaces for parking vehicles on public roads, such as Tupper Street, Almirante Latorre, José Miguel Carrera, Domeyko and Claudio Gay, among others.

Access

There are seven accesses to the central block of the Beauchef Campus. Only the main entrance is freely accessed, without TUI (Smart University Card).

Main access - through Beauchef 850, through the emblematic School Building, which houses the Central Library, classrooms and study rooms, the Gorbea auditorium, among others. This building gives way to the central courtyard, which in turn connects with various departmental , laboratory and administrative buildings.

Southeast Access - Electrical Engineering: through Tupper Avenue 2007, through the Electrical Engineering Department Building.

Southwest Access - Chemical: by Av. Tupper 2069, where the Mining Engineering building is located.

Northeast Access - Civil/Geophysics: by Av. Blanco Encalada 2002, through the building of the Departments of Civil Engineering and Geophysics.

Northwest Access - Physics: through Blanco Encalada Avenue 2008, where the Physics Department is located.

Eastern Access - Geology: through Plaza Ercilla 803, through the Department of Geology.

Beauchef 851 Access - through Beauchef (west side), where there are classrooms, laboratories, offices, sports and recreation spaces, a swimming Pool and parking lots.
